The Need

Boys Town North Florida is always looking for unique, innovative ways to deliver our life-changing services to more children and families in the Tallahassee area. Through these efforts, we identify specific needs that are not being met in the community and develop a plan for enhancing and expanding programs so that more people can benefit.

As more families have turned to Boys Town North Florida for help, we have seen the need to add a welcoming facility where:

- Children can access academic resources and receive tutoring and mentoring services that will help them find success in school
- Boys and girls can receive therapy in a kid-friendly therapeutic environment and wait for appointments in a quiet, comfortable, stress-free area

- Children can learn about and enjoy art, music and dance, opportunities that may not have been available to them in the past
- Children who are in out-of-home placements can visit with their biological families in a safe, family-friendly place
- Boys Town Foster Parents can focus on necessary training and meetings while their foster children are cared for in kid-friendly environment
- Parents can improve their child-rearing skills through Boys Town parenting classes

ART Town Features

Perhaps the most unique feature of **ART Town** is that it can provide individualized or group assistance, resources and encouragement to children and families that are facing a wide variety of challenges or situations. This includes:

- Families in crisis
- Foster families that need more support
- Parents with adopted children who have special needs
- Children who are struggling in school
- Children who have never had opportunities to express themselves creatively
- Children who are leaving foster care and need support and independentliving skills
 - Families that are working toward reunification

The Solution

Boys Town's answer to these needs is ART Town!

ART Town at Boys Town North Florida is a retreat where children and families can concentrate on restoring their spirit and healing their soul.

ART stands for **Art**, **Resources and Training**. The overall concept focuses on providing a professionally supervised, therapeutic, central location where children and families can experience personal growth in a charming and welcoming environment.

The conceptual design for the **ART Town** building and grounds is to be uplifting and inspiring, with an artistic and inviting beauty. It will be a place of peaceful rejuvenation that children and families look forward to visiting again and again.

Boys Town North Florida has purchased a house on two and a half acres of land adjacent to our Tallahassee campus that will be converted into the **ART Town** facility. A comprehensive renovation will create rooms and open spaces where teaching, training, therapeutic arts-related activities, meetings and counseling sessions can take place in a quiet, private setting. Currently, such activities are not offered due to a lack of space, or children and families have to wait for or receive services in a facility that is designed for business and administrative operations.

New facility expectations:

- Help an additional 30 to 50 children a year through academic tutoring and mentoring
- Provide Foster Parent training that will result in safe foster homes for an additional 30 children a year
- Provide parent training to families from across the Tallahassee area, positively impacting hundreds of children every year







At ART Town Children and Families will find:

ART. Through unique arts experiences designed specifically for the purpose of therapy, children can rejuvenate and restore their sense of self and improve and enhance their physical, mental and emotional well-being. Whether they are enjoying painting, singing, dancing, gardening or other forms of the arts, children will enjoy the stimulation and rewards of creative accomplishments.

The premise of art therapy is that the creative process allows for artistic self-expression, which helps individuals solve conflicts, manage behavior, improve self-esteem, develop self-awareness and insight, manage stress and develop interpersonal skills. The art therapy process integrates theories of human development, the use of visual arts and the process of creating.

Many studies show that creative engagement in arts-related activities has a therapeutic benefit for children and can lead to higher levels of achievement, particularly among disadvantaged youth. For example, Shirley Brice Heath's 10-year study of after-school programs for at-risk youth found that, compared to athletic/academic- or community service-focused programs, art-based programs for disadvantaged youth were associated with the greatest impact on youths' personal lives and academic performance¹. Also, the YouthARTS Development Project, conducted by federal agencies and local art agencies in three major cities, showed promising results from the use of art-based delinquency prevention programs². The National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) and the U.S. Department of Justice's Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) partnered to conduct a national evaluation of the project.

RESOURCES. Children can benefit from working on computers, reading books and tapping into other resources that provide much-needed individualized tutoring and mentoring. **ART Town** also will offer therapy sessions and a psychiatric clinic that can help elevate children to a better place emotionally. Staff also will oversee supervised visits for children and families that may be separated and are working toward reunification or finding another permanent placement. **TRAINING.** Parents will be able to attend Boys Town Common Sense Parenting[®] (CSP) classes, where they can learn skills and strategies for praising their children's good behavior, using effective discipline and consequences, and developing healthy family relationships. Also, Boys Town Foster Parents will receive professional training in a centralized, familiar gathering place designed specifically for meetings and instructional sessions. This training provides valuable tools for all caregivers and better prepares them to help children overcome the challenges they face and move toward a happier, healthier future.
