

## **YOUR 2024 IMPACT**

At Boys Town Louisiana, we provide an array of life-changing youth care and healthcare services that meet each child and family exactly where they are so they get the **right kind** of **care**, at the **right time**, in the **right way**.

# Together, we served and impacted nearly 1,000 children in Louisiana.

#### » Care Coordination Services

**237 children in 100 families** received intensive, family-centered case management services to help them navigate through complex systems such as the mental health care system, school systems and available community resources.

### » In-Home Family Services

**135 children and 56 families** learned how to handle issues and **prevent them** from becoming more disruptive in the home.

## » Boys Town National Hotline

**472 calls from Louisiana** were answered and **1 suicide in progress was prevented** by our Boys Town National Hotline Crisis Counselors.

#### » Boys Town Common Sense Parenting

11 families and caregivers learned new skills by building on their parenting strengths and developing healthy relationships with their children.

## » Family Home Program

**34 boys and girls** lived in family-style residential homes learning social and independent-living skills to help them on a **path to success**.

#### » Intervention and Assessment

We **provided care for 45** abused, neglected, runaway and delinquent youth ages 12 to 17 by removing them from dangerous situations, **assessing their needs** and beginning to work toward **family reunification** or other permanent care.

### » Early Head Start

**319 children** and their families received high-quality, comprehensive and seamless school readiness services to help prepare their children for success in school.

#### » Successful Futures

**22 youth** received senior planning, **life skills training** and workforce development to facilitate a **successful transition** to independent living through college attendance, employment and securing affordable housing.

#### » My Community Cares

**126 children and 57 families** were connected with community services and supports to promote child and family well-being, **decrease incidents** of child abuse and neglect and prevent unnecessary entries into foster care.
