

YOUR 2025 IMPACT

At Boys Town Louisiana, we provide an array of life-changing youth care and healthcare services that meet each child and family exactly where they are so they get the **right kind of care**, at the **right time**, in the **right way**.

Together, we served and impacted nearly 1,250 children in Louisiana.

» Care Coordination Services

244 children in 100 families received intensive, family-centered case management services to help them navigate through complex systems such as the mental health care system, school systems and available community resources.

» In-Home Family Services

115 children and 50 families learned how to handle issues and **prevent them** from becoming more disruptive in the home.

» Boys Town National Hotline

368 calls from Louisiana were answered and **1 suicide in progress was prevented** by our Boys Town National Hotline Crisis Counselors.

» Boys Town Common Sense Parenting

13 families and caregivers learned **new skills by building on their parenting strengths** and developing **healthy relationships** with their children.

» Family Home Program

28 boys and girls lived in family-style residential homes learning social and independent-living skills to help them on a **path to success**.

» Intervention and Assessment

We **provided care for 45** abused, neglected, runaway and delinquent youth ages 12 to 17 by removing them from dangerous situations, **assessing their needs** and beginning to work toward **family reunification** or other permanent care.

» Early Head Start

505 children and their families were provided high-quality, comprehensive and seamless school readiness services they needed to prepare their children for success in school.

» Successful Futures

24 youth received senior planning, **life skills training** and workforce development to facilitate a **successful transition** to independent living by attending college or working and securing affordable housing.

» My Community Cares

246 children and 104 families were connected with community services and supports to promote child and family well-being, **decrease incidents** of child abuse and neglect and prevent unnecessary entries into foster care.
