

At Boys Town Nevada, we provide an array of life-changing youth care and behavioral health care services that meet each child and family exactly where they are, so they get the **right kind** of **care**, at the **right time**, in the **right way**.

Together, we directly served 8,076 children in Nevada.

In-Home Family Services

923 children and 386 families not only learned how to handle challenging and disruptive behavioral issues after they arise, but also how to **prevent them** from becoming more of an issue in the first place, while they remain in their home.

>> Outpatient Behavioral Health Clinic

387 children and their families who were experiencing any of a wide variety of challenges including ADHD, school difficulties, emotional issues, noncompliance and/or relationship concerns found support and guidance. We continue to conduct autism assessments to ensure children are getting the proper resources to support their needs.

Care Coordination Services

168 children in 64 families received intensive, family-centered case management services to help them navigate through complex systems such as the mental health care system, school systems and available community resources.

Boys Town National Hotline®

881 calls from Nevada were answered and **4 suicides in progress were prevented** by our Hotline crisis counselors.

Boys Town Common Sense Parenting®

255 families and caregivers learned **new skills by building on their parenting strengths** and developing **healthy relationships** with their children.

Our Behavior Interventionists worked with **6,046 students** in their classrooms to develop **stronger social skills that promote more positive learning**. In addition, we **trained over 2,000** Clark County School District educators in our model and **supported 83 schools** in the 2023/2024 school year.
