Grade 4

• French: January 23 - February 1 (completed)

English Language Arts (Part 1): February 6 – 10

English Language Arts (Part 2): April 11-28

Math: May / June (TBD)

Grade 6 (MEQ exams)

• French: May 1 – 10

English Language Arts: May 11 - 24

Math: June 6 – June 8

Please make every effort to ensure that your child is present for school on these dates. Since each exam takes place over the course of a few days, missing a day during this period would have a significant impact on their final result
