<u>SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST – Closed Classroom</u> <u>School Year – 2025-26</u>

Suggested Supplies	Optional Supplies (not required but helpful)
2 packages of Markers (Washable)	Tissue box (when sick or if they have sensitivities and prefer a specific brand)
1 pack of wax crayons (qty 16 to 32)	Diapers if required (with tabs to facilitate changing and preparation for independent toileting)
6 large glue sticks (Pritt or LePage recommended)	Your preferred brand of diaper wipes - Labeled (if necessary)
3 packages of dry erase markers	Bingo Stampers (Dollar store quality fine)
2 smocks (1 for art, 1 for eating)	Velcro dots / strips (Dollar store quality fine)
Lunch Box (labelled)	Preferred fidget / sensory toy
Water Bottle (labelled)	Other items/supplies based on the needs of the child may be agreed upon at the Case Conference in August.
Change of clothes (we recommend 3 pairs of socks, 4 underwear, 2 pairs of pants, 2 t-shirts non uniform is fine) (labelled)	

School Dress Code: White tops navy blue or black bottoms. (Exact wording from Student Agenda)

<u>Dress Code</u>: **Students are to wear plain white tops**. Sleeveless and/or cropped tops should not be considered "School Appropriate". **Students are to wear plain navy blue or black pants, skirts or Bermuda shorts.**

Jeans, joggers, track pants are NOT suitable for everyday school use.

Considerations should be made BEFORE sending your child to school as to what is "Elementary School Appropriate". Things for consideration include but are not limited to skirt length, amount of make-up, appropriate footwear etc. Furthermore, certain jewelry and piercings can become a safety concern as such should be given careful consideration before they enter the school.

Sweaters worn by students should be navy blue or black. Graphic 'hoodies' are not suitable for class.

With regard to <u>ALL DRESS CODE RULES</u> (including dress down days and P.E. classes): Good taste and sensibility are the guiding principles to which the school reserves the right to adhere to.
