3.	<p><u>Proposal for EMSB Action Plan – Quebec Construction Training Offensive Phase III – For Consultation</u></p> <p>WHEREAS according to Resolution #23-12-19-12.2, the English Montreal School Board (EMSB) assigned space at the Lester B. Pearson High School to Adult Education and Vocational Studies (AEVS) for the vocational programs in the construction sector;</p> <p>WHEREAS the EMSB has been granted provisional authorisation to offer the Carpentry (DVS) program;</p> <p>WHEREAS the Ministère de l'Éducation du Québec (MEQ) announced the launch of Phase III of the Quebec Construction Training Offensive, focusing exclusively on long-term vocational training programs leading to a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS);</p> <p>WHEREAS the MEQ has authorised the EMSB to open additional cohorts beyond those permitted by the provisional authorisation;</p> <p>WHEREAS the EMSB proposes that these additional cohorts be delivered by the Rosemount Technology Centre and housed at Lester B. Pearson High School;</p> <p>WHEREAS Adult Education and Vocational Services (AEVS) will require additional space at Lester B. Pearson High School to accommodate the expansion of this program;</p>

	<p>WHEREAS certain classrooms of Lester B. Pearson High School may need to be modified to meet the program requirements;</p> <p>WHEREAS the Lester B. Pearson High School governing board, the Rosemount Technology Centre governing board and the EMSB Parents' Committee be invited to submit their views no later than December 5, 2025;</p> <p>WHEREAS the English Montreal School Board Long Range Planning Committee met on November 3, 2025, and recommended that the EMSB assign the space at Lester B. Pearson High School, as per attached document, to AEVS;</p> <p>WHEREAS due to the urgency to implement this program, the Long Range Planning Committee recommends a shorter consultation period in order to meet all the requirements;</p> <p>IT WAS MOVED BY MS. MARIA CORSI AND UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE LONG RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE, THAT the Council of Commissioners approve for consultation that the EMSB assign the space at Lester B.
