



LEARN Virtual Summer School 2019

WHY: This Online Summer School program is a solution that can be used to enhance your present Summer School programs. It is also geared towards schools or School Boards who do not offer a summer school program, and/or for students who do not have access to summer school services at a nearby school.

WHO: All students registered in an English School Board within the province may access this service. These services are for students who have already completed a year of study in a course and who:

- wish to improve their final results, or
- did not receive a passing grade as a final result and wish to rewrite the final exam,
- are approved (if necessary) by their School Board to take a summer course,
- have at least a 50% mark. Since the cost is \$250 per course, we recommend this for most students because our goal is to assure success whenever possible, and reduce a needless expense for families.

WHERE:

- All classes are offered from the comfort of home or any location that offers a reliable internet connection. This provides flexibility and freedom to learn from anywhere, which is convenient, effective and aligned with the way students learn today.
- All classes are facilitated by a certified and qualified subject teacher.
- All our summer school courses are offered online during real-time sessions that are interactive and engaging.

HOW to Register: LEARN will provide a digital registration form on our website (www.learnquebec.ca/summerschool). Parents can register their child and pay directly online. Once a student has registered, LEARN will communicate with the student's school to share the details of the course chosen and exam to be written. **In order to improve communication in June and during the summer sessions, please send to LEARN the name and email address of the contact person who will help coordinate summer sessions at your school or School Board. Evaluations:

- All students are required to write non-uniform and Ministry exams at an exam writing center, designated by the School Board or student's school. We request that School Boards provide Ms. Schwartz with this information, so that we can direct students to the appropriate individuals within your board when we are asked.
- **NOTE:** C1 ONLY Math Exams (Secondary I to III) - This exam will be written on the last day of summer school with the online teacher, in the online session.

- If a School Board does not have a non-uniform exam, please contact LEARN for more information.
- On the LEARN registration form, and on our website, students and parents will be advised that it is their responsibility to register for the exam with their school or School Board. **LEARN does not register students for exams.**
- It is recommended that schools have textbooks available for their students during summer session. **LEARN does not provide textbooks.**
