SECONDARY III FIFTEEN-DAY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

The Educational Services Department is offering a Summer Program based on the essential components of courses offered during the regular school year.

Most courses for the summer school program will be 100% in person learning, with the exception of Physical Education, Dance, Drama, and Music.

ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- Courses are only available for EMSB students
- Online registration on the EMSB website will take place from Wednesday June 25 to Monday, June 30th
- Students will be able to register for up to three (3) summer courses
- Courses will be offered only if there are enough registrants
- The registration for Summer School must be completed online
- Any registrations requested after the deadline will only be considered if space permits

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All students with a grade below 60% may register for the July session.

There is no final exam at the end of any secondary 3 course. Students are therefore required to complete **all** assessments during the three week period as assigned by their teacher. If any work is missing, they will not be considered as having completed the course successfully.

Students will receive a final grade for each course they take. A student who receives a passing grade (60% or above) will be considered to have passed the course for all purposes.

Cost for Summer School:

All in-school courses cost \$250. All independent projects (see below) will cost \$50.

Summer School Hours

Students may take up to three in-school courses. The courses will be scheduled in one of the following blocks:

Block A - 8:30 - 10:00 Block B - 10:10 - 11:40 Block C - 12:30 - 2:00

Students who have both a Block B and a Block C course will be able to eat their lunch in an assigned classroom. If students wish to bring a lunch with them, they will have to keep their lunch with them at all times stored in their backpacks. No lockers will be assigned to students, nor will refrigerators be available. The school cafeteria will NOT be available.
