SECONDARY I - II FIFTEEN-DAY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

The Educational Services Department is offering a Summer Program based on the essential components of courses offered during the regular school year.

The summer school program will be 100% distance (virtual) learning. **Students MUST be physically in Canada to be able to access their courses.**

ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- Courses are only available for EMSB students
- Spaces are not limited, additional teachers will be hired if necessary
- Online registration on the EMSB website will take place from **Wednesday June 24 to Monday, June 29th**
- Students will be able to register for up to two (2) summer courses
- Courses will be offered only if there are enough registrants
- The registration for Summer School must be completed online
- Any registrations requested after the deadline will only be considered if space permits

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All students with a grade below 60% may register for the July session.

There is no final exam at the end of any secondary 1-2 course. Students are therefore required to complete **all** assessments during the three-week period as assigned by their teacher. If any work is missing, they will not be considered as having completed the course successfully.

The focus of this three-week session is on solidifying student understanding of key foundational concepts. Therefore, secondary 1 – 2 summer school courses are not graded; schools will be provided with a list of students who attended summer school, detailing the student's attendance, participation and progress over the session.

Cost for Summer School:

All courses cost \$300.
