- Design, facilitate, and evaluate professional development workshops, training sessions, and collaborative learning opportunities focused on curriculum implementation, effective instructional practices, and pedagogical innovation
- Collaborate with teachers in the development of high-quality learning and assessment situations, support classroom-based experimentation, and promote the implementation of evidence-informed instructional practices.
- Participate, as required, in multidisciplinary teams to develop, review, and monitor individualized education plans (IEPs) for students with disabilities, social maladjustments, or learning difficulties.
- Advises, management, teaching or professional staff on matters related to curriculum, assessment, instructional practices, and professional development, and contribute to the planning, implementation, and evaluation of professional learning initiatives.
