ACTIVITY: Grocery Store



What you will need:

- Grocery store flyers, toy/real food
- Baskets/Containers (optional)

Markers Tape/glue Scissors Paper

What to do:



- Using store ads, your child will create their own grocery store.
 - Cut out a variety of different items from the ads.
 - If using toys or real food/objects, group the items together into a basket.
 - Decide on the number and type of groups according to your child's level. If needed, use visuals for each group. Example categories:
 - Things we eat (fruit, vegetable, desserts, etc)
 - Things we drink (soft drinks, juice, etc)
 - Colour, Size
 - Sort the items. Find at least 3 items per group and paste them (see example).
 - Count the number of items in each category when complete.
- Depending on your child's need, follow the suggestions provided below:

VOCABULARY

Ensure your child hears target words many times. If they can't remember a word, provide the first sound ("ch" for cheese). Discuss quantity

concepts: more, less

ARTICULATION

Model clear speech and fix-up your child's articulation errors. Provide feedback when they say sounds correctly ("You said the III in lemon so nicely!)

SOCIAL COMMUNICATION

Take turns in conversation to discuss which foods you like and which you don't like. Do role play with your child: shopper, cashier, clerk

HANDWRITING

Practice tracing, copying or writing the first letter of each item. Capital letters are easier to form than lower case letters. Provide an example of how to form the letter.

SCISSOR SKILLS

Trace around the image with a marker. The thicker the boundary and the fewer the snips, the easier the task will be. Click here for tips for scissor skills and for how scissor skills develop

GROSS MOTOR

If using baskets, put items far away or in different rooms of the house. Ask your child to run, jump, crawl, or do an animal walk each time they sort an item.
