LEARNQUEST - OFFERED BY MCGILL FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

We are pleased to share a new partnership with a McGill Student- Led Initiative called LEARNQUEST.

How does it work?

It works by the student and/or parent clicking a link or scanning a QR code on the flyer (see image on left) that will send them to an intake form to gather the information that is needed for them to see a tutor and any other contact info needed. Following the completion of the form, the student and their parents will be sent an email with a link where they can book their first appointment, and any subsequent appointments after that (an hour in duration). We encourage students and their parents to book bi-weekly sessions, but if less or more is necessary, then they can book appointments as needed as well. Whenever they book an appointment, they will be asked if they would like to join as a group, the subject of focus for the session, their confirmation number (found in the initial email with the link to the schedule) and other information to help guide them towards the right tutor. If the student chooses to join as a group, they will be asked to add the email of anyone else they want to have access to the meeting, allowing for a group tutoring session. Our tutors have specific time slots for which they are responsible for, and so a student can easily pick a time for which they're preferred tutor is available, but can also leave a note saying the tutor they would prefer. Appointments are available and can be booked from 5pm to 9pm on weekdays, and 9am to 12am on weekends. Session start in January.

HIGH SCHOOL HOMEWORK CLUB

Our **Homework Club**, a supportive and structured environment where students can complete their homework, receive guidance, and build good study habits. We have tutors who can support students across all subjects and grades.
