Evaluation Methods: Formative and Summative

Arts Plastiques:

- -Formative methods include ongoing observations of student's creative process, peer feedback and teacher check-ins during classwork.
- -Summative methods will include evaluation of completed projects, presentations and final creative pieces that demonstrate learned techniques and personal expression.

Arts Dramatiques:

- -Formative methods include continuous assessment through participation in warm-up activities, improvisations, group discussions and rehearsal feedback.
- -Summative methods include performances, scripted scenes and final presentations that showcase collaboration, creativity and understanding of dramatic concepts.
