SCHOOL CELL PHONE AND ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

In accordance with the Ministry of Education's directives, the use of cell phones and electronic devices is strictly prohibited during the school day, both inside the school building and on school grounds.

This policy applies to all electronic devices, including:

- Cell phones
- Smartwatches
- Headphones and earbuds
- Gaming consoles
- Any other personal electronic devices

Students are not permitted to use, display, or hold these devices from the moment they enter the school building until they leave at the end of the school day. This prohibition also extends to school grounds during school hours.

The purpose of this policy is to promote a focused, distraction-free learning environment and to encourage student engagement in academic and school-related activities.

Any student found using, holding, or displaying an electronic device during prohibited hours will have the device confiscated and returned by the administration at the end of the school day.
