



By virtue of the third paragraph of section 461 of the Education Act (EA), in the broad areas of learning, the Minister has prescribed activities or content to be integrated into the educational services provided to students at the elementary and secondary levels:

- compulsory content in Academic and Career Guidance Content (ACGC) for the third cycle of elementary school as well as for the first and second cycles of secondary school;
- compulsory content for the development of personal and social skills for all cycles of elementary and secondary school (content for preschool is also available but is not mandatory);
- compulsory content in Sexuality Education for students in the second, third, and fourth years of secondary school. This content complements the Culture and Citizenship of Quebec (CCQ) curriculum, in which most sexuality education concepts have been integrated. For students who are not taught the CCQ material, sexuality education content must be planned and delivered (content for preschool is also available but is not mandatory).

The administration, in collaboration with school staff, which includes the teaching staff, establishes a plan for each compulsory content, pursuant to section 89 of the Education Act. The planning aims to:

- ensure that all prescribed content is offered
- identify who is responsible for delivering the content
- ensure coherence and continuity in learning
- promote the integration of initiatives into school practices.

WHEREAS, the governing board is responsible for approving the planning proposed by the school administration;

It was moved by Antonio Petosa, seconded by Silvia Muzzo and resolved that the 2025-2026 Academic and Career Guidance Content (ACGC) curriculum plan, Sexuality Education Curriculum Plan and the Development of Personal and Social Competencies Plan be approved, as presented, to the Governing Board.
