

AIM HIGH PROGRAM 2025-26 Course Outline

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Subject: French

Overview:

All students are working on an Individual Education Plan and the course is designed with flexibility to alter lessons and assignments to help students achieve their goals. The curriculum is modified according to the needs of each student.

Students are usually given a printout of notes and a copy is made available on Google Classroom. Student work is usually done individually with occasional small group or partner work. Students have regular access to assistive technology when necessary.

Course content: This is a modified, basic French program.

Competency 1: Interaction in French

This may include listening comprehension exercises, oral reading, responding to oral stories and videos, dictées and other interactive means.

Competency 2: Reading in French

This includes assigned in class readings with response questions, group and individual reading.

Competency 3: Production in French

This includes grammar work sheets, written responses, work on Duolingo and J'accorde: Worksheets will be taken from a variety of French texts/workbooks including Envolée, Complices Plus, Ricochet, Moi je parle français, Essential French and others. The online platforms: Socrative will be used for quizzes and evaluations; Duolingo and J'accorde will be used both for in class assignments and homework. All students will be given their login information for both platforms and are responsible for having it at home. Other online interactive platforms such as Kahoot and Mauril may also be used.

Evaluations:

Students will be given a variety of tests and quizzes on Socrative, and also in class assignments to gauge their progress and mastery of the different grammar topics. Students will be evaluated on two or three competencies each term. Students will be provided both digital copies on Google classroom and hard copies of worksheets. They will have extra time to complete work and assistive technology as needed.

Homework will be mostly on Duolingo and J'accorde. Students will be given 1 week to complete assignments at home but occasionally they may get class time. Students who are unable to complete classwork in the given class time will be required to attend my remediation at lunch on days 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 9 and day 4 after school.
