### REMINDERS

- Students are expected to wear their full school uniform starting the first day. If you have not yet ordered, please contact Price & Buckland (https://www.pbuniforme.ca/en/). Flat, closed shoes are required (any color permitted).
- If a student is not in proper uniform, they will be sent home to change.
- Please note that Phys. Ed. uniforms are required and will be coordinated at a later date by the Phys. Ed. department.

• Cell phones, smartwatches, headphones, and similar devices are not permitted for use on school grounds. If seen, such items will be confiscated by staff and returned at the end of the day.

• Each teacher will provide a specific list during the first week of classes, but all students should arrive on the first day of regular classes (September 3rd) with a 1-inch binder, loose-leaf, and a pencil case (pencils, pens, eraser, highlighters).

On opening day, all students will receive their agenda. We encourage parents and guardians to go over the Code of Conduct in the student agenda with their children in order to understand the school's policies and procedures.

On opening day, all students will receive a locker, lock and combination. Note that school locks must not be removed or switched for a personal lock. These belong to the school and lost/damaged locks must be replaced by the student at a cost of \$10.
