Guiding principles

- 1. Revise ratios to weigh coded students with special needs
- 2. If the weight of a special needs child is used this year we would be considered at = 449 instead of 420
- 3. Provide resource for all grades in both languages as early as pre-k early intervention is key
- 4. Roll-over should be permitted to be able to implement project early in the year
- 5. Respect class size to consider the child awaiting assessment and weight of that special need.

c) Hockey Program for 2022 school year

Ms. Sammarco, Ms. Kachmar and Francesca Muro met Michael Buonincontri from Next Level Hockey to introduce a hockey program next year which can possibly attract more students. "Next level Hockey" youth development program – currently offered at Honoré Mercier doing well... we would be the only RDP school offering this program.

1 tier - Grade 1, 2, 3

2 tier Grade 4, 5, 6

Students enrolled would receive gear —with shirt and name and logo — broken up in three sessions approx. \$300 per session without bussing. The kids would have to go to Glaces de l'Est— on the ice at 4:30. Offering a one-way bussing but will have to pick up at the arena at an additional cost. More details regarding cost and time to be confirmed.

- Each child will be evaluated should have basics to skate but will take them.
- Learn to skate program pre-k and K, this would take place on ped day \$25 plus \$9 day care fees.
- Learn to Skate to be offered to all grades on ped days
- They would be bussed to glace de l'est with day care educators for one hour and come back.
- How will the kids get dressed? The team will help get on the ice.
- We are the only ones in RDP who have this program.
- We will be the LDVA Jets logo was designed.
