Mozaik Re-Registration & Course Selection Process

Our secondary 1-4 students will be taking part in our course selection process in preparation for our next academic year during the week of January 12-16, 2026. Students will be completing their choice of courses through Mozaik with the assistance of their parents. *For families who do not have a Mozaik account, you may create an account prior to the process taking place.*

The Guidance Counselors will be visiting classes prior to the course selection week to prepare the students about their options. If students are not returning to LBP, we ask that an email be sent to the level secretary advising us that your child will not be returning. More information will follow later in the week in an email with the instructions on how to complete the ONLINE COURSE SELECTION process.

Code of Conduct & Uniform Reminders

We kindly ask that you take a few moments to review our school's **Code of Conduct** with your child coming into this second half of the school year, to ensure a shared understanding of expectations that support a positive learning environment.

Please pay special attention to the **Uniform Clarification** section included below, as it outlines important guidelines for student attire.

Please note the following for the uniform:

School joggers ARE NOT part of the uniform and can only be worn for Dance and Phys. Ed. Class. Students may only wear them into school or leave with them if these classes take place period 1 and period 4.

School pants must be navy blue and MATCH the Top Marks school pant. Although the supplier is strongly recommended, students must respect the navy-blue pant.

Track pants and yoga pants are NOT permitted. Pants must have pockets and resemble a semi-formal pant.

Students wearing the school zip-up must be wearing a solid color underneath, and no visible logos are permitted. These zip-ups must be zipped all the way up if the school polo is not worn underneath.

No boots allowed in class. This includes all Uggs Boots and slip ons. FLAT shoes appropriate for school are required at all times.

In Phys. Ed. Students may wear their Phys. Ed uniform. Black or navy hoodies joggers are also allowed in the gym, as it gets cold in the winter.

CEGEP Applications/Voc. Training/Ad. Education

We will be meeting our secondary 5 students shortly to discuss the general application process for CEGEP, Vocational Training, and Adult Education. Important procedures and deadlines will be reviewed in order to assist our students during this important time for planning.
