NEW REVISED School Cell Phone & Electronic Device Ban Policy 2025-2026

1. Policy Statement

In accordance with the Ministry of Education's directives, the use of cell phones and electronic devices in school and school grounds is strictly prohibited during the school day.

This includes cellphones, game consoles, headphones, earbuds, and smart watches.

The use of cellphones and electronic devices are prohibited from the moment students enter the school building and to the moment they leave the building during the school day. This ban extends to the school grounds during school hours.

This policy aims to foster a focused, distraction-free learning environment, ensuring student engagement in academics and school activities.

2. Scope of the Ban

The restriction applies to all areas within school property, including:

- Classrooms
- Locker Bay
- Hallways
- Cafeteria
- Plaza
- Bathrooms
- Gymnasium
- Outdoor spaces within school grounds including the Hurteau and PM Favier terraces, and the school field (during the indicated times).

Cell phones must remain on silent and stored away in lockers during school hours.

3. Consequences for Violations

Any student **caught using, holding, or displaying** an electronic device during prohibited hours will face **immediate suspension** as per this policy (students will be sent home for the day). Additional actions may be taken depending on the severity of the violation.

4. Exceptions

This policy does not apply to:

Medical necessity, with prior approval from the administration.

5. Enforcement & Compliance

Teachers and staff are responsible for enforcing this policy consistently. Parents and guardians are encouraged to support this initiative by reminding students of the importance of a phone-free learning environment as per the Minister of Education's directives.
