4.6 mTransport Implementation on Buses 2022-2023

- mTransport is an app to help improve safety when traveling on school bus and for the school to monitor the location of the buses
- Implemented in 10 EMSB schools in past 2 years. It will be Nesbitt's turn next year.
- Preparation phase: information is sent out, buss passes will have a scannable QR code but the QR will only be used months later.
- Mid-Oct to beginning Nov: we will go live, buss passes will be scanned when students get on and off the busses.
- Data collected as to whether a child got on and off the bus and tracking the location of the busses.
- No option for parents to opt out if they want to use the buss services.
- Some GB parents had serious concerns regarding privacy rights and protection of sensitive data (i.e., child's name, address, telephone number and school).

4.7 Cycliste Averti – https://cyclisteaverti.velo.gc.ca

- Melissa Alexis :
- A program in collaboration with Velo Quebec. Helps to sensitize children about bike safety.
- Fully subsidized, no cost to the school
- 6 hours of teaching time (theory)
- Trained cyclists come and take students out on bikes. 2 trained professionals; one in the front and
 one in the back, and they practice the theory of what they learned.
- Have bicycles available for children that do not have (total 26 bikes)
- Age: grades 5 & 6
- Details: 6 hours theory + 6 hours practice in a closed circuit (big gym), bike ride in the neighborhood (with bookends), and final practice exam. A certificate is awarded at the end.
- Teacher will obtain training for the 6 hours that they would need to teach.
- Nicholas R. will discuss with staff and get back to us.
