→ **Apple picking K4 & K5:** K4 & K5 Students had a terrific trip to the apple orchard!

→ **Picture day:** Classes had their pictures taken on October 23.

→ **Halloween:** Halloween Task force had many activities going on around the school, dancing, arts & crafts, Fashion Show, spooky story time under the parachute, and a Haunted House created by our Grade 6 students. A great time was had by all!

→ **Dress down to lift up:** Fundraiser was very successful. We raised a little over 700\$ for student activities.

→ **Remembrance Day:** 11:15 am Mr. Koutsoulis addressed the school via intercom; we had a minute of silence and a student in Grade 6 read an essay she had written about a soldier.

→ **PPO TCBY fundraiser:** Our first TCBY fundraiser for PPO was also a success. It raised 372.70\$

→ **Parent conferences:** Majority of parents were present. Online sign up had some glitches but were easily adjusted. Some parents are still not comfortable with online access, therefore teachers reached out and scheduled appointment times for them. Overall, it turned out very positive.

→ **IEPs:** A new IEP protocol was put in place to ensure quality IEPs for special education students. Parents were asked to participate by doing a google form and sharing information to contribute to goal setting for their child/ren. IEPs were reviewed and signed by parents during parent conferences.

→ **Book Fair:** Very successful book fair. Students had fun shopping and leaving it open during parent teacher conference day was very profitable. We have around 2000\$ in scholastic credits for our school.

→ **Parkdale At Peace Kindness Assembly:** Mr. Koutsoulis addressed the students to educate about Conflict vs. Bullying, Demonstrating Kindness and Tolerance, and students took the Pledge of Kindness. Our K4 students in Ms. Melissa's class sang a Kindness Song and a student in Grade 5 read a beautiful poem in honor of our Peace and Kindness Month.

→ **Recess Success:** In January, selected students will participate in Recess Success, a student Mentorship where older students in Grade 5 & 6 organize games at morning and afternoon recess for Cycle One Students. Students will have 2 formal leadership training sessions at Lunch hour for recess success with Everblast.

→ **Partnership with South Asian woman's community group:** Grade 4 & 5 students will be invited to participate in an extra-curricular lunch hour group to encourage wellness, and communication.

→ **Holiday Food Drive:** Thank you to the entire Parkdale Community. We collected enough food for 18 large boxes to help Parkdale families in need. Our Grade 6 Leadership Crew and Staff sorted the donations and organized the food boxes.
