Morning Arrival:

- Daycare students will be brought to their class at 8:35am.
- Bus students will arrive at 8:40am. They will disembark and go to their class.
- Walkers will arrive at 8:45am and enter the school on a free entry basis.
 - o Grades 1 will enter the school from the Garden door through the park gate entrance.

- Grades 2-3 will enter the school from the JR door through the park gate entrance.
- Grade 4-5 & 6 students will enter via the main gate and proceed to the SR entrance day care entrance.

Life Threatening Food Allergies

Our school community is devoted to the well-being and health of all children, as such, we are a peanut free school. Some of the children who attend our school are extremely allergic to peanuts, nuts and other foods. Parents are asked to omit foods containing nuts and /or peanuts from your child's snacks and meals. These measures are intended above all to provide a safe environment for these children. If there are students who have allergies other than nuts in your child's class, the teachers will send home a notice of the foods that should be omitted from your child's lunch box.

We thank you for your cooperation.

School Bus

In the afternoon, attendance is taken for the students taking the bus. If there is a change in your schedule and your child will not be taking the bus on a particular day, please make sure to write a note in the agenda advising the office that your child will not be taking the bus. We need your cooperation in this matter.

If your child received a bus pass and will not use the bus service at dismissal, please call the school secretary to inform her of this change. (514-323-6586 Ms. Cesie).

Lunch Time

All students will be having lunch in their classroom. Please supply a <u>cloth place mat</u> for lunch. The mat will be returned home daily. If a parent is picking up their child for lunch, it is imperative you write a note in the agenda stating so.

Memos

We will send all memos to the email address that was given to us on the child's confidential form. If you have not done so, please make sure to send us the email address of both parents. All memos that require a response will be sent as a hard copy via your child.

Parent Information Evening /General Assembly

On Thursday, September 16th, the staff at Pierre de Coubertin School will be having an Information Evening. This will be done virtually as we did last year. On this occasion, parents from Pre-K to Cycle 3 will meet with their child's teachers to receive important information regarding the competencies that will be targeted for the year, homework assignments, classroom rules and practices. Please make a special effort to attend this evening because you play an important role in your child's academic success.

Medication at School

Students are NEVER allowed to have medication (including cough drops) of any kind in their possession. If your child is required to take medication prescribed by a doctor while at school, a Consent Form signed by the parent must be given to the school secretary. This must be accompanied by the medication in the original container from the pharmacy (including dispensing label), with the doctor's name clearly visible on the label. No medication will be given to a child unless it is prescribed by a doctor. A student is encouraged to wear an allergy belt which holds their EpiPen. If your child has asthma, a pump must be kept at school. The child may not keep it in the school bag.
