New School Programming

As of this school year, PDC will continue to follow a Bilingual Program but on a Monday through Friday Schedule.

This means that your child will have a full day of English and French twice a week, followed by a half day on Fridays for both languages.

All students will continue to receive the allocated minutes in all subject areas.

First Day Procedure

We know the first day of school can bring big emotions for both children and parents. To help ease the transition, please note that parents are not permitted into the school yard. Students should carry their own supplies on the first day, and our staff will be there to assist our youngest learners.

When students arrive, they should look for the balloon that marks their grade level and head to that table—this is where they will meet their homeroom teacher for the year.

Lunch Requirements

All students have lunch in their classroom. Please supply a cloth place mat for lunch. The mat will be returned home daily.

Please note that all utensils must also be brought from home.

Lastly, a reusable water bottle is highly encouraged. We have a water station for them to fill their bottles throughout the day.

If a parent is picking up their child for lunch, it is imperative you write a note in the agenda stating so.

Allergies

We are a peanut free school. Some of our students are extremely allergic to peanuts, nuts and other foods.

Parents are asked to omit foods containing nuts and /or peanuts from your child's snacks and meals.

These measures are intended above all to provide a safe environment for these children. If there are students who have allergies other than nuts in your child's class, the teachers will send home a notice of the foods that should be omitted from your child's lunchbox.

Bussing

We have been advised that street work will take place from September 5 to mid-October going south on Viau between Des Grandes Prairies & Robert.

Please plan for extra travel time to ensure a punctual arrival.

Entry & Dismissal Procedures

Please follow the procedures below:



Daycare students will be brought to their class at 8:35am.

Bus students will arrive at 8:40am. They will disembark and go to their class at 8:43am.

Walkers will arrive at 8:45am and enter the school on a free entry basis. They will be allowed to enter the school yard as of 8:45am.

ENTRY:

Grades 1-2-3 are to use the Park Gates then the JR door. Grade 4-5 & 6 students must use the Main Gates and proceed to the SR entrance - daycare entrance.

K5A/B classes will use the kindergarten yard at 8:45 a.m.

K5 C/D classes will use the Park Gates

K4 classes will enter the main gate at 8:50am and line up under the shelter.

Please note that staff members are on duty until 8:50am to monitor the students' arrival. Please arrive on time. We ask all parents to respect these times. If your child arrives after 8:50am, please use the front entrance.

Dismissal:

All students will be dismissed at 3:48pm.

Grades 1-2-3 walkers, will exit from the park gate

Grades 4-5-6 walkers will exit from the main gate.

K4 will exit from Room 31 (K yard)

K5 A/B dismissed through classroom door (door 1 & 2)

K5C dismissed through door 1 and K5D door 2

K4/K5/Closed Classes: Further explanation will be given to parents during your progressive entry times on September 2 & 3.



If you are interested in presenting yourself as a GB candidate, please be present at the general assembly. Candidates should be ready to make a brief presentation, introducing themselves and describing their reasons for their candidacy. They must be nominated by a parent in attendance that evening.

In addition, the election of a Parent Delegate and an Alternate to the EMSB's Parent's Committee must be voted in during our General Assembly. This person must be a member of the Governing Board.

Dismissal Procedures
