Dear Students & Parents/Guardians,

The End-of-Year (May/June) exam period is coming up; please see the attached May/June Exam Schedule.

Please take note of the following:

- **There are some scheduled exams during class time and outside of the school timetable in the months of May and June.** Students must be present on those days and must provide proper justification with documentation (ex: medical note) if absent and/or late for exams.
- **The last day of regular classes for Sec.3-4-5 students is Tuesday, June 9th, 2026.**
- **The last day of regular classes for Sec.1-2 students is Friday, June 12th, 2026**
- **All students** must be **present** and **on-time** for their exams. Students will not be permitted into an exam more than 30 minutes after the start time. For late arrivals past that time, and for all absences, proper justification and documentation is needed: medial note, death certificate, police report, etc.

Other Important information for students who have exams only on a specific date (*Exclusively for Sec.3-4-5 students as of June 10th & Sec.1-2 students as of June 15th up until June 18th):

- Student entrance (Door 16) will be open as of 8:00AM.
- As of June 15th, there will be a Tutoring Center available for students who have questions for our tutors between 8:00am and 2:00pm in the foyer (outside the Auditorium) . Students are to come prepared with their questions; service is on a 1st come, 1st serve basis. Students cannot remain in the school once they have been seen by one of our tutors.
- Upon completion of an examination, students are required to leave the school QUICKLY AND QUIETLY.
- Students should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of their exam
- Exam room locations will be posted each day on a whiteboard at the student entrance – Door 16
- Students must stay for a minimum of half the allotted exam time. (Ex: If the exam is 3 hours long, students may leave after 1.5 hours, if they have finished. Students are encouraged to stay as long as needed to complete their exam and review their work, within the allowed time frame.)
- Students with an accommodation on their IEP permitting extra time for evaluations may remain in their exam room for extra time equaling one third of the officially allotted exam time. This means that these students may take 4 hours for a set 3-hour exam, 3h20m for a set 2.5-hour exam, and 2h40min for a set 2-hour exam
- All students without time accommodations on an IEP are permitted an extra 5 minutes for every hour of an exam. (Ex: At the end of a 3-hour exam, students are given an extra 15 minutes, if needed.)
- Students must arrive at exam sessions **in full uniform** and prepared with all their required materials.
- Cell phones, smartwatches, and/or other electronic devices (except for school computers provided by Resource) are not permitted during exams.
- All devices and other personal belongings must be left on a desk at the front of the exam room.
- Cheating will not be tolerated.
- Any student who is found cheating during an examination will receive an exam mark of zero
