1. INTRODUCTION

Evaluation Standards and Procedures at **ROSEMOUNT HIGH SCHOOL** were proposed by a committee of teachers and approved by the school principal. Their aim is to define concrete actions in an effort to ensure that evaluation practices are consistent with the vision of evaluation adopted in the Québec Education Program. The discussions surrounding the development of these Evaluation Standards and Procedures also led to increased harmonization of evaluation practices in an effort to ensure consistency throughout the school.

FIELD OF APPLICATION

The Evaluation Standards and Procedures in this document apply to Secondary 1 to 5 and elementary grade levels. They cover each of the stages in the evaluation process, namely:

1. Planning of evaluation
2. Information gathering and interpretation
3. Judgment
4. Decision/action
5. Communication of results

The Evaluation Standards and Procedures in this document are in effect as of **September 1st, 2026**.
