



I hope that you all had a great March Break and are keeping well!

Let's work together!

Thank you to all who brought their school spirit when celebrating St. Patrick's Day at school and/or the school dance. Thank you to our PPO for organizing the Family Dance. These night events are meant to bring our school community together and we appreciate our parents and staff for volunteering their time and efforts in making these events happen.

Lunch fees are overdue. If you have not done so, please call the school and make an appointment with Ms Elisabeth. The second instalment of the lunch fees of \$144 was due January 28, 2026. School fees were due in September 2025, as these fees are for your child's school supplies. All fees must be paid. **We understand that times might be hard, and so if a payment schedule needs to be put into place, please speak to me.** If payments are not paid in a timely manner, the Legal Department will need to be informed.
