## Norman Hayward Budd

Norman Hayward Budd was born in 1922.

He was born in Montreal, Quebec to Mr. and Mrs. Frederick Hayward Budd.

Norman Hayward Budd attended Westmount High School and based on his year of birth graduated between the years of 1937-1939.

Budd held the rank of able seaman in the Canadian Merchant Navy S.S through Vancouver Island (Montreal). As an able seaman he could've worked as a watch stander, a day worker or a combination of both roles.

In 1941, many boats headed from Montreal to Belfast were lost. Budd was on one of the boats that caught fire due to a mine explosion. The fire was not extinguished and sunk. Budd and many others died due to the attack. The date of death was confirmed to be October 15, 1941. He would have been 19 years of age at the time of his death.

Budd and other soldiers died at sea and are buried at the Halifax Memorial, in Nova Scotia, Canada. His grave reference is panel 18. At this memorial there is a granite Cross of Sacrifice which is over 12-meters high and has over 20 panels on it with over 3000 soldiers' names. The size of this monument allows for all ships coming into Halifax to see it.

As of June 19, 2003, the Government of Canada designated September 3rd of each year to honor and acknowledge the Merchant Navy.




There is little information regarding Budd's early life before the war or after his death.
