

William Andrew Eden Jr. is a Westmount High School graduate Class of 1942. He graduated at 17. William was a Flying Officer and died on February 12th, 1945. "Where all think alike, no one thinks very much". That was William's quote in the 1945 Westmount High school yearbook. His probable destination was a floor walker at Morgan's. He was in the Cadet and the ski team in 1941. He is honoured on a Canadian airforce grave located in Singapore.
