

Robert Robinson Law was born on the 28th of March 1923 in Germany. He was a flight lieutenant in the Royal Canadian Air Force during World War II. He died of wounds while prisoner of war on January 19th 1945. Bob Law was buried at the Rheinberg War Cemetery in Germany.



The battle of Normandy took place on Tuesday 6 June, 1944. The Normandy Invasion began with overnight parachute and glider landings, massive air attacks and naval bombardments. In the early morning there were amphibious landings on five beaches code named Juno, Gold, Omaha, Utah, and Sword.
